Un-audited figures

Following on from a sustained level of activity in 2007, **ACTIELEC TECHNOLOGIES** has registered a good performance in the first quarter 2008: Group turnover as at 31st March 2008 has progressed by 12.5 % to € 60.9m as against € 54.1m in the same period 2007. Growth was driven by both branches of the Group: **SODIELEC** for the telecommunications market and **ACTIA** for the automotive market.

**AUTOMOTIVE BRANCH**

The increase in turnover by 12.3 % to € 53.9m was delivered by the following activities:

- ✓ **Diagnostics**, with a solid progression in sales in the area of analyses and equipment, particularly for technical inspection;
- ✓ **On-board Systems**, with the expected growth in chronotachographs and telematic portals;
- ✓ **Services**, whose know-how is in strong demand for the production of significant quantities of new products at very high levels of quality.



### **TELECOMMUNICATIONS BRANCH**

As expected, growth in turnover for Ground Stations is satisfactory, particularly for Defence and in the area of broadcasting, where new ranges of transmitters have given back leadership to **SODIELEC**. Turnover for the first quarter 2008 of the TELECOMMUNICATIONS branch thus progresses by 14.3 % to € 7.0m.

Europe is the geographic zone strongly driving the business in the first quarter 2008 (+ 15.8 % to € 54.9m). Turnover achieved by overseas subsidiaries represents 40.7 % of Group revenues.

### **Outlook for 2008**

In spite of difficult economic conditions, the Group is reconfirming its objective for turnover growth in the 2008 year at € 255m. With its technical quality and its innovations, **ACTIELEC TECHNOLOGIES** is benefiting from renewed confidence from its major customers.
